Report of the Task Force assigned to review the
By Laws of the Five College Learning in Retirement
Program

This working committee met on February 20 and February 27, 1992. The decision was made to re-write the entire statement of by-laws, since that seemed the most potentially effective way to provide by laws which would facilitate our program; this seemed advisable in consideration of the growth and development of the 5CLIR since originally by laws were adapted from a model in use by another institute.

Careful attention was paid to the matter of writing by laws which would allow us to do better in all aspects of the operation of the program in which procedures and definitions arose from by law regulations.

On February 28, 1992 draft copies of the recommended by laws were circulated to task force members, and the following schedule for informing the council and the general membership was planned:

presentation to the Council, March 12, 1992

Call to a special general membership meeting April 2, 1992 to seek the approval of the membership recommendation for implementation of new bylaws effective with the 92-93 membership year
