

September 10, 1992

Meeting of the Council of the Five College Learning in Retirement Program with Barbara Southworth, the President presiding. Present: Lieson, Ungar, McAfee, Wisneski, Beal, Keppler, Gibson, Keating, Quint, Goodwin, Greenberg.

Copies of the minutes for the August 18th Council meeting were distributed. There was a brief discussion of the item in the minutes referring to the use of "private commercial space". The reason for the motion passed (Aug 18) was clarified and all agreed that the organization is best served by using space on the Five College campuses. The secretary's report was approved.

Bill Lieson noted that a treasurer's report was not ready at this time and that he and Ann Keppler, the new treasurer, and Lucy Greenberg would be working together on a report following the day's council meeting.

Ellen Goodwin volunteered to pursue the matter of folding chairs for the office to be available for Council meetings. She suggested the possibility of piggy-backing on an order for chairs with the Friends of the Jones Library System. The Council is thinking, in terms of a dozen chairs.

There was a general discussion of plans for a Council retreat in mid-January. Bill Lieson is beginning to coordinate plans. The President urges Council members to present to Bill in writing any suggestions about format, location, timing, etc.

Lucy McAfee will be in contact with the Fine Arts Center about volunteer greeters for the Center programs. She will discuss with them the possibility of a training session for greeters.

There was no further business and a motion to adjourn was made and seconded.
